4 One semester of LANG 100 (English Diction) is required, as is at least one semester of either LANG 101 (Italian Diction), LANG 200 (German Diction), or LANG 201 (French Diction).

5 Secondary lessons in voice or, if the student is an undergraduate voice major, on an instrument.

6 Must be an upper-division MUTH or MHST course on a topic in twentieth- or twenty-first-century music.

7 To be selected from upper-division Music Theory or Music History courses, or graduate-level Private Applied or Private Composition Study. May not include credits used to satisfy undergraduate degree.
