<sup>1</sup> Jazz performance students must audition for jazz ensembles at the start of each academic year. The Jazz Faculty will place students into large jazz ensembles (JAZZ 700-703; JAZZ 704 (Jazz Trombone Choir) may be counted as large ensemble for rhythm section players only). Students must complete at least four credits (two semesters) in large jazz ensembles. The remaining 12 required jazz ensemble credits may be fulfilled through additional participation in large jazz ensembles or through participation in small jazz ensembles (JAZZ 703, 803-805). JAZZ 703 may be counted as a large or small jazz ensemble.

<sup>2</sup> For jazz percussionists and jazz vocalists. All other concentrations take an additional two credits of free electives. Upon consultation with the student's advisor, studio faculty, or department chair, a student may apply for a waiver to use two credits of PVST 078 (Jazz Piano Secondary Lessons) for APST 110.

<sup>3</sup> For non-keyboard concentrations. Jazz pianists and jazz vibraphonists take an additional two credits of free electives. The JAZZ 110 requirement may be fulfilled through two credits of PVST 078 Jazz Piano Secondary Lessons determined upon consultation with the student's advisor, studio faculty, or department chair.

<sup>4</sup> A music theory placement test score of 80 or higher is a prerequisite for MUTH 131. Students with lower scores must successfully complete MUTH 120 before taking MUTH 131.

<sup>5</sup> Jazz majors may fulfill one of their 200-level Music Theory courses with JAZZ 221 (Advanced Jazz Theory). JAZZ 221 is offered in the fall semester and recommended for sophomore year.

<sup>6</sup> Bachelor of Music students are expected to complete 32 credits of liberal arts electives. Jazz majors are expected to fulfill 8 of these credits with MHST/JAZZ/AAST 290/291 (Intro to African American Music) and 24 credits with other liberal arts electives.

<sup>7</sup> Students may register for any credited Conservatory or Arts and Sciences course that will count toward the total required credits.
