SEMESTER & YEAR

Minimum of 5 out of 9 full courses must be CAST courses.

1. ONE 100 or 200 level CAST introductory course.

May not include CAST 200: Theories and Methods. An introductory course can count towards the Methodological Breadth requirement if it is a CAST course)

2. CAST 200: Theories and Methods.

Prerequisite: An introductory course.

3. ONE 300 level seminar.

Must be a CAST course and cannot be satisfied through a cross-referenced course in another department. A 300 level CAST seminar can count towards the Methodological Breadth requirement.

4. CAST 500: Senior capstone research seminar.

Prerequisites: An introductory course and a 200 level CAST course. Majors are strongly encouraged to complete at least one 300 level CAST course before enrolling in the capstone.

5. THREE Methodological Breadth courses.

All three courses must be CAST courses to fulfill the requirement. A **CAST** introductory AND 300 level seminar course can both count towards the Methodological Breadth.
